We've Been Busy...

- 339 Dogs/Puppies and 363 Cats/Kittens were adopted, each spayed/neutered and vaccinated prior to the adoption finalization!
- Assisted in the emergency operations of the Tri-City Animal Shelter following the dismissal of the previous contractor.
- 1,466 Volunteer hours were donated to our shelter! A huge thank you to all who dedicate their time supporting these animals!
- Held Covid19-safe virtual community outreach events, including the popular Fast & Furriest.
