We've Been Busy...

- 420 Dogs/Puppies and 418 Cats/Kittens were adopted, each spayed/neutered and vaccinated prior to the adoption finalization!
- Partnering with Tri-Cities Animal Shelter providing spay/neuter services and Happily Ever After Transfer Program!
- 2,355 Volunteer hours were donated to our shelter! A huge thank you to all who dedicate their time supporting these animals!
- Providing 800 pets food from our Community Food Pantry to help them stay in their homes!
